



Prof. Olufemi A. Bamiro B.Sc, Ph.D Mechanical Engineering

Prof Bamiro graduated with B.Sc. First Class Honours in mechanical engineering from Nottingham University, England in 1971 and Ph.D mechanical engineering from McGill University, Montreal, Canada in 1975. He joined the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Technology, University of Ibadan, Ibadan, Nigeria as Lecturer in 1975 and rose rapidly to become full professor in 1983. He held many administrative positions at the University culminating in the vice-chancellorship from 2005-2010. In the area of science and technology policy studies, he has served Nigeria in several capacities: Secretary of the 24-man Panel that produced the Energy Policy for Nigeria in 1984; Member of the 6-man Committee that prepared the blue-print for the implementation of the National Science and Technology Policy for Nigeria in 1987; Coordinator of the Science and Technology Sector Study of the Nigerian Perspective Plan conducted for the National Planning Commission of Nigeria in 1994; and UNESCO Consultant for the UNESCO-sponsored Reform of the National Science, Technology and Innovation System in Nigeria. He is currently the chairman of the Steering and Monitoring Committee of the National Research Fund under the Tertiary Education Trust Fund and also that of the Lagos State Research Grant Council.
